Charleston County Parks brings its Silent Dance Party to Hollywood!

This unique party experience, taking place from 4 – 6 p.m., will be held at the gym of the Schroder Recreation Center, located at 7224 Hwy.162 in Hollywood, SC.

All guests to the Silent Dance Party will wear wireless glowing headphones. Two live DJs will play a variety of music, and attendees will have the ability to switch between the two musical genres. Drinks and snacks will be available for participants to enjoy during the event outside of the gym area; however, no food or beverages are allowed in the gym.
