The Reckoning returns to Palmetto Park Jam on March 8

[MOUNT PLEASANT] – Kick back and let the good vibes roll in – Palmetto Park Jam is back on Sunday, March 8 at Palmetto Islands County Park! Experience the magic of the Grateful Dead as the tribute band The Reckoning returns to headline this concert in the park.

Held in a family-friendly festival atmosphere in Mount Pleasant Palmetto Islands County Park, Palmetto Park Jam will also feature food trucks and craft vendors for guests to explore and enjoy. Gates open at 11 a.m. Charleston-based rock trio Hollifield will play live starting at 12 p.m., and The Reckoning will take the stage from 1:30 – 4:30 p.m.

Beloved local tribute band The Reckoning is known for channeling the spirit, sound, and soulful improvisation of The Grateful Dead. Expect extended jams, familiar favorites, and plenty of moments that'll have everyone in the park dancing.

Concert admission will be charged per vehicle, so groups of guests are encouraged to carpool and arrive together in the same vehicle. **Standard sized vehicles of up to 15 people will be \$20 per vehicle in advance, or \$30 per vehicle at the gate, if not sold out.** Gold Pass holders will receive free admission at the gate (one vehicle of up to 15 people per Gold Pass presented on site; no ticket required). Parking is limited at Palmetto Islands County Park, so a limited number of tickets will be sold and the event could sell out in advance. Purchasing tickets in advance at CharlestonCountyParks.com ([direct link](#)) is highly recommended. Gold Pass holders are not guaranteed admission if the event has sold out, so they are encouraged to arrive early that day.

Food and beverages will be available for purchase on site. For more information, visit the [event webpage](#) at ccprc.com/ppj. Attendees are encouraged to bring chairs and blankets to the event. Outside food, alcohol and coolers are prohibited at Palmetto Park Jam. Dogs are welcome, but must remain leashed.

Palmetto Islands County Park will be closed to non-concert goers during the day on Sunday, March 8, reopening to the public at 4:30 p.m.
